



Azure Kingfisher

Alcedo azurea

The Azure Kingfisher is usually found around slow flowing, freshwater streams and wetlands, near shady and overhanging vegetation.

It plunges from overhanging perches into water to catch its prey, such as fish, insects and sometimes frogs.

The Azure Kingfisher nests in a burrow, which is dug out in the side of the riverbank and can be up to 130cm long.
