


Eastern Brown Snake

Pseudonaja textilis

The Eastern Brown Snake is the species responsible for most deaths caused by snakebite in Australia and is currently ranked the second most venomous snake in the world.

It is commonly found right across Australia from wet and dry forests to woodlands and grasslands.

This species feeds mostly on small mammals, particularly rodents.
