

Dillwynia cinerascens

This shrub species grows up to 1.5metres in height in dry forest and woodland areas over much of Australia.

This drought tolerant plant attracts butterflies and is listed as a significant species in the Goulburn Broken Catchment.

It flowers during spring producing small pea-like flowers clustered at the end of its branches.
