

RiverConnect: Information for Kinders and Early Learning Centres in Greater Shepparton.

RiverConnect is a partnership program which works with agencies and the community to care for, protect and promote the rivers and wetlands within Greater Shepparton. Part of this project is the Education program, which encourages local schools, kinders and tertiary education facilities to learn about our rivers and their environs, in an outdoor learning framework, through place based education opportunities.

Our work with Kinders and Early Learning Centres has included visits to teach children about the river, environment and its critters, reading the children books about the environment, eco art play. It has also included joining the centres who currently run bush kinder when they visit bush settings, providing interactive learning opportunities and nature play activities.

There are a couple of ways you can stay up to date with what we're up to and what opportunities might suit your children.

- Facebook group called RiverConnect-Greater Shepparton. This is where we share our events/activities, interesting articles or warm fuzzy posts. We have also run the occasional live school holiday activity here, as well as created video 'how to' clips for activities for families during the holidays whilst under COVID restrictions.
- Instagram account simply called RiverConnect. As above.

- I send out a semi regular enewsletter to teachers, you can request to be added as a recipient. This is information targeted to teachers, but has to cover all age groups so not everything will suit you. Generally it highlights particular learning opportunities coming up, such as tree planting season and other seasonal activities, new educational opportunities, new technology or citizen science, and some info on what we've been up to.
